

Fall 2024 Housing Assignment Process

This process is only for current residential students. Information for new First Year Students and Transfers will be posted.

To participate in the room selection process for the 2024-2025 academic year students must submit a \$200 resident deposit and complete the initial housing application.

Deposit/Application:

The \$200 resident deposit and the initial housing application are required to move forward in room selection.

Deposits and applications must be submitted between February 19 at 9:00 AM EST and 5:00 PM EST on March 1, 2024. Students can pay and apply through the housing portal. Students can access the portal using the "Housing Application" button found on the [Housing and Residential Life myMarist](#). Parents can pay the deposit using the payment portal found on the [Student Financial Services myMarist](#).

*Students must be eligible to live on campus to pay a housing deposit. If you have questions about your eligibility, please contact Housing.

Ineligible students are:

- Commuter Students.
- Graduate Students.
- Students who have lived on campus for 4 years.
- Students who have withdrawn from housing who now live off campus.
- Students who are graduating.

***Please note the following:**

If a student needs to apply for a deposit extension, the student must meet with a representative in the Office of Housing and Residential Life in Rotunda 387 before February 29, 2024 5:00 PM EST.

If your student would like to apply an existing credit on your account for your room deposit, your student must meet with a representative in Student Financial Services between February 19 and March 1, 2024.

Priority Points:

Priority points will be released on February 26, 2024, on the housing portal. Students will have until March 7, 2024, to make any corrections.

Roommate/Single Group Forms:

Roommate and Single Group forms will collect through the housing portal. Students can access this step in the process starting on March 20-March 29, 2024.

Room Selection:

Room Selection will take place online over 2 separate weeks in April. Dates will be posted, once confirmed.

Phase 2 and 3 Housing Selection

Information about Phase 2 and 3 will be posted closer to Housing Selection in April.

Residential Locations:

Current freshmen: Midrise, Upper and Lower West Cedar Townhouses, Foy Townhouses, Upper and Lower New Townhouses and designated Fulton Street Townhouses.

Sophomores: applying for and accepted to Special Interest Housing will be determined, based on application interest.

Current sophomores and juniors: Fulton Street Townhouses, New Fulton Street Townhouses, Ward Hall, Lavelle Hall, O'Shea Hall and McCormick Hall.
